

St. Francis County Master Gardener Scholarship
Deadline to Apply: April 1st

Description: This scholarship is to assist a St. Francis County Arkansas resident in pursuing a four-year degree in agriculture or agriculture related fields, including but not limited to horticulture, botany, agronomy, forestry, plant science, landscape, turf management, and vet science. Applicants must have a 2.5 grade point average .

Scholarships are awarded based on the funds raised by the St. Francis County Master Gardeners. Total dollar amount awarded may vary from year to year. The amount awarded will range from \$500 to \$2000 depending upon funds raised by the St. Francis County Master Gardeners and the number of eligible applicants. Priority will be given to current recipients.

Instructions:

First-time Applicants:

1. Fill out all sections completely. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
2. Attach a copy of your high school transcript, ACT (or equivalent) scores, and a copy of your college transcript (if at least one semester has been completed) .
3. Attach essay from Career Goals section.
4. Sign and date the application in the space provided.
5. Ensure all documents are stapled or clipped together and mail application so that it arrives no later than April 1.

For those reapplying:

1. Fill out all sections completely. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
2. Attach copy of current college transcript including current semester grades earned at mid- term of spring semester.
3. Attach essay from the Career Goals section.
4. Sign and date the application in the space provided.
5. Ensure all documents are stapled or clipped together and mail application so that it arrives no later than April 1.
