

Horsemen's Short Course

Overview

The Horsemen's Short Course is designed to help Arkansans develop a better understanding of a variety of topics concerning horse ownership and management. These courses are only available in a multimeeting format. For example, a county may have the short course last 3 sessions, while others may go to as many as 7 sessions.

Topics include, but are not limited to

- 1. Nutrition
- 2. Health care
- 3. Facility design
- 4. Horse training principles
- 5. Reproduction
- 6. Horse psychology and behavior
- 7. Hoof care
- 8. Laws and Insurance



There is flexibility depending on the needs of the county on determining amount and what type of subject matter to cover during each meeting. When conducting these trainings, local veterinarians, farriers, and other experts in their respective fields are and can be used as instructors.
